Whilst wandering those seemingly *directionless* paths, I was inspired to create this ænigma.

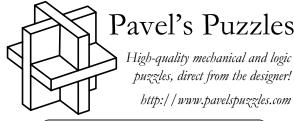

For your aid in this task, I have pre-filled some of the squares of the grid: pray do not alter any such givens.

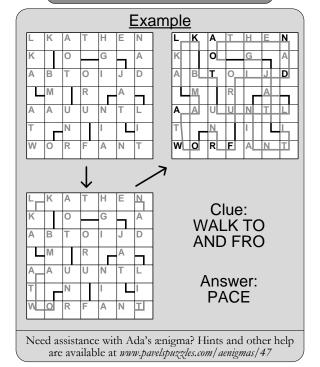

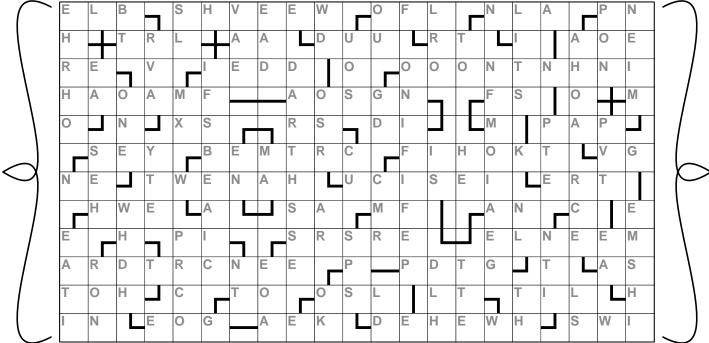
