Into every white cell in the grid below please enter a single digit 'twist 1 and 6 (from 1 to 4 in the example); a selection of those digits have been provided for you. Within any boldly outlined 7×7 subgrid (the whole grid in the example), pray do not repeat a digit in any row or column. Honouring my reflections above, in each row or column of each subgrid, ensure that the digits strictly alternate between increasing and decreasing, in either order.

Once you have completed your work, you may move on to finding the final answer to my ænigma. Take note of the letters placed below the grid. Advance each letter in the alphabet (wrapping around from Z to A if necessary) by the sum of the prime digits, either placed or given, in the corresponding grid column. Reading the resulting letters from left to right will reveal a clue to your final answer.
